1. Snowplowing and/or removal of snow from the following parking lots and sidewalks:

1.1 High School

1.1.1 North student parking lot

1.1.2 West staff parking lot

1.1.3 Receiving area

1.1.4 Vocational Education area

1.1.5 All roads and drives on site including the school portion of the walking trail

1.1.6 Connecting road to elementary school

1.1.7 All sidewalks around high school building

1.2 Middle School

1.2.1 Adult parking lot adjacent to football field

1.2.2 Staff parking lots 1 and 2 along College Street

1.2.3 Old Vocational School parking lot

1.2.4 Connecting road along west side of football field

1.2.5 All sidewalks around middle school building

1.3 Elementary School

1.3.1 Parking lot north of school

1.3.2 Parking lot south of school

1.3.3 Division Street from Hwy. K to parking lot

1.3.4 Exit road from north parking lot

1.3.5 North entrance/exit road to ball fields

1.3.6 All sidewalks around elementary school building

2. The Contract will:

- 2.1 Provide all personnel, supplies, equipment and insurance to plow and remove snow.
- 2.2 Automatically remove snow if in excess of two inches fall – if in doubt, call the Buildings & Grounds Supervisor
- 2.3 Complete all snow plowing by **5:00 a.m.** whenever possible when school is in session;
- 2.4 When school is not in session, provide **(by 7 a.m.)** access to buildings and space for some staff parking.
- 2.5 The District may wish to add other clean-up and salt/sand services on an as needed, hourly basis.

3. Contractor is liable for damage to school property and will repair all damage to original condition.

4. All bids must name the District as a certificate holder on liability insurance; include references.

5. Contractor may be required to provide the District with a performance bond in the amount of \$30,000.
