Club Descriptions

100 Shot Club - Students will shoot up to 100 shots first, followed by some open gym time where they can enjoy competition with friends!

Art Club - See where your creativity will lead you! Once a week, students will tackle fun art projects and develop new artistic skills.

Baking Club - Learn to properly read a recipe, make sweet treats & other goodies.

"Be the Best Me" Fitness Club - Students will rotate through a planned circuit of exercises that will improve coordination, strength, and agility. The students will be coached on improving performance in the exercises, daily nutrition, and making good choices. "The Choices we make, make us!" Metrics like vertical leap, shuttle run speed, and dash time will be monitored.

Climbing Wall Club - Climbing Wall Club is an exciting opportunity for students to explore the sport of rock climbing. The club aims to introduce students to the fundamentals of both traverse climbing and top rope climbing, equipping them with climbing safety knowledge and honing their climbing techniques. Students will have ample opportunities to use the SMS climbing wall and to work hands-on with climbing equipment. In climbing wall club students will have fun as they learn to overcome challenges, work as a team, and increase their physical fitness.

Color Guard - Color Guard is a form of dance while twirling flags in correspondence to choreographed music. Come give it a try.

Chess Club - Learn rules and strategies and compete in a fun game of Chess.

Cooking Club- Learn the in's and out's of what it takes to be a cook! Students will practice following recipes and learn what is necessary to cook tasty foods.

Cross Country Ski Club - New to skiing? Interested in learning? Skied a little? Raced before? All levels of skiers welcome! Skiers will work as a team to learn the lifelong sport of skiing, build leadership skills, and enjoy Wisconsin winters!

Esports- Esports is not simply defined as competitive video gaming, but rather it is an immersive culture that brings scholar gamers together on a competitive platform to showcase their talents in gaming. There will be team practices and competitions.

Fat Tire Bike Club - This club is designed to teach students how to competently and safely ride bikes off road on groomed snow singletrack trails in the woods. Students will learn Fat Tire bike skills including climbing, cornering, and shifting. They will also learn basic cold weather sport safety and indoor bike maintenance when it's too cold to be outside (significantly below zero). Prior demonstrated safe biking ability is a prerequisite for this club.

Students who show up without proper cold weather gear will not be permitted to ride with the club. Below freezing temps requires proper footwear, long sleeves long pants gloves and potentially a hat or buff to help protect face/ears when cold and windy or there is rain/snow/sleet.

Humane Society Club - Learn how to properly care for animals and clean up after them. Enjoy time petting and playing with different animals and learn about the Washburn County Humane Society.

In Motion - Come learn basic tumbling skills with proper form and technique. Each skill learned will progress to the next skill level as students master beginning skills.

Knex/Lego Club- Work on your engineering skills by creating all different kinds of structures.

LEAP - Creating leaders one LEAP at a time through team building and enrichment activities at Lakeland.

Tutor Club- Get support in math, ELA, science, or social studies from our high school tutors.

Policy Information - *Everyone, please review and sign*

- I understand that each student attending the CLC Before & After School program must complete all enrollment forms and an emergency form if they do not attend the Spooner Middle School at any time during the day. All forms must be accurate and on file prior to attending the program.
- I understand that it is my responsibility to pick up my student by or before 5:30pm. Failure to do so may result in contacting police and/or dismissal from programming.
- If my child will be absent, I will notify CLC staff via note, email, skyward or phone call. Two unexcused absences will result in dismissal from their clubs.
- I understand that Before & After School programming enforces rules of the school day. Students who disrupt the learning environment will be dismissed from the privilege of the program. If my child is asked to leave the program due to inappropriate behavior, I will be required to pick up my child early.
- I understand that CLC staff is mandated to report any suspicion of child abuse or neglect to Washburn County Department of Human Services or the City of Spooner Police Department.
- I understand I will be notified if my child is injured or ill during programming and that I may be required to pick up my student immediately, as there is no nurse or support staff available during Before & After School programming hours.
- I understand students are not to use their phones during club time and are required to participate in activities laid out by club leaders and teachers. If my child refuses to participate, I may be asked to pick up my child and they may possibly be removed temporarily or indefinitely from programming.
- I understand that I am signing my child up for specified days/times and they are expected to attend the days registered for.
- I understand SAFETY is the number one priority for programming. If my child is physically or verbally hurting another student, they may be asked to leave immediately and removed from the program. Respect for peers and staff is an expectation.

NOTE: In the case of inclement weather, cancellations and delays will be posted on the school's website and Facebook page, and broadcast on local radio stations. Please check the school's website or Facebook page often, especially during questionable weather.
